

1. Samuel Taylor (we need to confirm his historical details) was likely born 16 April 1813 (likely not in NSW as I'm having difficulty identifying Samuel on the NSW historical records of births, deaths and marriages – lots of Taylors with similar names) but Barry Charlesworth (son of Joyce Charlesworth - nee Taylor, Mum's sister) has given me a reference on Samuel Taylor presenting something to his son Charles (who at that stage was 43 and had been married to Louisa Roseworn for about 13 years) on Samuel's 77 birthday being 16/4/1890), and, he, Samuel, may have died after his son Charles who died in 1894 at age of about 47. Samuel married Mary Kelly according to some or Mary James according to others (records on the NSW register of births, deaths and marriages suggest Mary James) in 1850 (for Mary James) at the St Lawrence's Presbyterian Church in Sydney.
2. I have no other specific information on Mary James other than there are several Mary James born in NSW in 1829 to an Ann and Samuel (and Joseph) James. This would make Mary 16 years or so younger than Samuel, born in 1813. There are only two other Mary James born earlier than 1829, one in 1824 the other 1825. No details in the register as to Church or District.
3. Samuel and Mary James had at least four children:
 - a. Charles Bap 1847 and born 1847
 - b. Anne (reported as Ann in earlier work) bap 13/5/1849 birth 7/3/1849
 - i. Married
 - ii. Children
 - c. Ellen bap 16/2/1850 birth 26/12/1850
 - i. Married Sydney Robert Parry Lorking in 1876
 - ii. Children
 - d. Louise born 1858 registered under the Bathurst District which coincides with other references to Bathurst.
 - i. Married
 - ii. Children

All but Louise were baptised at St Lawrence Church of England Sydney. 1851 Electoral Roll had Samuel Taylor as a holder of freehold property in Canterbury. Samuel was at first a shopkeeper and then a manufacturer and is spoken of by Mum as the originator of Morteen fly spray. The family business was very successful but Charles died at the young age of 47 and his wife remarried and the father Samuel's family business moved across to the two daughters on their father Samuel's death.

4. Charles Taylor was born in 1847 and died 27/2/1894. He married a Louisa Roseworn in Bathurst 15/9/1877 at the age of 29 or 30. I can't be sure of the details on Louisa Roseworn yet but she died a Louisa Cubis (remarrying on Charles's death her sister's widowed husband a Mr Cubis. Charles and Louisa had 6 children:
 - a. Samuel E born 22/3/1878 died 5/5/1955
 - b. Charles Theodore born 16/11/1879
 - c. Forest Sydney born 16/12/1881 died 4/6/1948
 - d. Earnest Oswald born 15/1/1884
 - e. Joseph Charles born 26/1/1886 died 6/5/1964
 - f. Charley born 17/11/1890

I don't have dates for all these children as yet nor much of their history. Mum remembers several of them as uncles and had kept in touch with some of their children till fairly recent years. We're hoping to relocate and speak with Edward Taylor the son of Samuel E Taylor. Hopefully someone will have more details of Samuel (Snr), his wife, and their antecedents.

5. Forest Sydney Taylor (b 16/12/1881 & d 4/6/1948) [son of Charles Taylor and Louisa Roseworn of Canterbury Sydney, was born in suburb of Glebe then called Forest Lodge, in Sydney, hence "Sydney after Forest"]. Forest liked to be called Sydney. He married Mary Jane Wright Hutton [daughter of Jane C Harrower (nee Hutton)].
 - a. Mary Jane Wright Hutton was born in August 1881, the daughter of Jane C Hutton. Jane was married to Robert Harrower in April 1884 in Alva, Stirlingshire, Scotland prior to both departing from Glasgow to Australia by ship with Mary Jane. Mary Jane and with mother Jane and father Robert Harrower sailed on the Cloncurry which departed Glasgow and arrived Brisbane Australia on October 31 1884 when Mary Jane was 3 year old. Mary died 12/3/1920 at 35 years of age.

- b. Some assumptions are made about the full parentage of Mary Jane Wright Hutton. A clue is perhaps in the parentage of Robert Harrower: father was similarly named Robert Harrow but mother was Mary Wright from Brackead, Tillicoultry, Scotland.
- c. After settling in Highgate Street Bexley in NSW, Robert and Jane had 7 brothers and sisters to Mary Jane:
 - 1. Anne born c 1885
 - 2. Robert 29 June 1887
 - 3. William c 1890
 - 4. Donald c 1893
 - 5. David Ogilvie McDonald 12 September 1894
 - 6. Sarah Margaret 8 November 1899
 - 7. Jeannie Alveen 26 January 1903
- 6. Forest Sydney and Mary Jane had 9 children, 6 sons and 3 daughters (dates for b and d, as applicable, require completion):
 - a. Earnest Sydney (Ernie) born 1902 Hurstville died 1927 Wollongong
 - b. Arthur Robert (Bob) born 1903 Hurstville
 - c. Louise Irene (Rene) born 1905 Hurstville
 - d. William Charles (Bill) born 1906 Rockdale
 - e. Donald Ferguson (Don) born ??? died 1933 Wollongong
 - f. Joyce Doris born 1909 Hurstville
 - g. Sidney Samuel (Sid) born 1912 Paddington
 - h. Jean Mary born 1914 Canterbury
 - i. David J born 1916 Bulli died 1916
 - j. Jack Alan born 1917 Bulli
- 7. Jean Mary can remember at 6 years of age being required to run up the rail track from Coal Cliff to the Stanwell Park rail viaduct (then under construction) where her brother Arthur Robert (Bob) then 16 years of age, was working, to tell him that their mother had died.
- 8. Earnest Sydney married Ollie who was widowed when Earnest was electrocuted. They had sons Raymond (married Meryl (d) and moved to Queensland) and Don. Ollie remarried.
- 9. Arthur Robert married Hilder. They had the following children:
 - a. June who married Bill Neaves (d) and had the following children:
 - i. Billy (who married ? (42719094) – and have children Darrell, Donna, Lee Anne
 - ii. Merrylyn who married Bob Obrien – and had Jody who married -- and has Cohen
 - iii. Glenda who married Ross Kay – and have children Shanon and Kylee who inturn have children (Shanon) Dylon, and (Kylee) Tiarne, Mitchel and Zaac
 - iv. John who married Hayley – and have children Taylah and Jackson
 - v. Shayne who married Peter and have children Ben, Christy, and Malcolm

 - b. George who never married
